

Perspective® controls many emerged weeds and weeds in both the seedling and rosette stages of growth. Refer to the product label for the complete list of weeds controlled.

How to get the best results with a fall application of Perspective®

Apply Perspective® at a rate of 4.75 ounces per acre. Perspective® may be applied at rates up to 8.0 ounces per acre, if needed, depending upon the weeds that are present at the time of application. Application rates cannot exceed 11.0 ounces per acre per year.

For best results via ground application, use at least 10 gallons per acre (GPA) spray solution.

Warm, moist conditions following application accelerate the herbicidal activity of Perspective®; cold, dry conditions delay the herbicidal activity.

Weeds hardened off by drought or other plant stresses are less susceptible to Perspective®.

Best results for long-term weed control occur where grasses and other vegetation are allowed to recover from adverse environmental conditions and compete with susceptible weeds.
